Easy Aspects

(would have been done in any case)

- Web Site: UNIMORE will take care
 - But everyone should contribute to keep it alive
 - Global project log
 - Local web sites / information encouraged – well coordinated with the main site
- Publications
 - High quality (hopefully)
 - Open access (not sure how to deal with e.g., journals and LNCS, to be verified)
 - Remember to ack SAPERE! **“This work has been supported by the EU-FP7-FET Proactive project SAPERE – Self-aware Pervasive Service Ecosystems, under contract no. 256873”**
 - Or simple **“Work supported by the EU SAPERE Project under contract no. 256873”**
- White papers
 - Quite easy, but has to be done!
 - A LaTeX style under development

Workshop and Tutorial

- At least one international workshop
 - This can be quite easy, but has to be done
 - Anyone can propose a location (or, better, a co-location) and proactively take care
 - Let's exchange proposals and ideas in an open way via the mailing list
- At least one tutorial
 - It should be a "SAPERERE" tutorial – FZ and other who wants to participate
 - But if you do tutorials around in these years try to sell them as SAPERE one, at least in portions of it



Open Source Software

- Very Easy...
 - Will take care starting from the second year

Localized Press Releases

- Required by the contract
- We have been forced to declare we would have done
- Everybody **MUST** do that, not only the coordinator!
 - I cannot make a press release for, e.g., Scotland...
- Anyone who draft some text please have this available to the whole consortium

Collaboration Plans

- We MUST interact and collaborate with the other projects
 - 2% of resources explicitly devoted to that
- This will be via the AWARE Coordination Action
- We all know Ben Paechter and Jennifer Willies already from PERADA Activities
- My colleague Giacomo Cabri is within AWARE
- So let's not underestimate the need to be reactive to the AWARE request
 - And be ready to spend money for AWARE (we have to!)

Exploitation Plans

- We are FET, so we are not obliged to immediately exploit results in industry
- Yet, we must show there are ways to exploit them
 - By our own on our local world
 - By raising industrial interest
- Key actions to be done
 - Involving industries in use cases identification requirements collection (Alois, in T5.1, with the cooperation of everybody!!!) THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT AND CRITICAL FOR THE FIRST YEAR
 - Targeted dissemination (let's involve industrial people in workshop and tutorials, and let's send to industry the while papers) and seminar performed at industries
